But as the war begins, her town is invaded by Russians, led by the charming-turned-vengeful officer, who takes her prisoner and threatens death if she won’t marry him. With a total runtime of 108 minutes, the historical drama will be accompanied by live music played on the theater’s mighty Wurlitzer organ.
