Acclaimed Circus Troupe Brings Acrobatic Antics to Weinberg Center

FREDERICK, Md., Wednesday, October 4, 2017 — Hailed by The New York Times for its “irrepressible spirit of fun,” award-winning circus troupe Flip FabriQue will bring its acrobatic antics to the Weinberg Center for the Arts stage on Wednesday, October 18 at 7:00pm. The performance marks the start of the Weinberg’s 2017-2018 Family Series, combining stunts, a one-of-a-kind “trampowall,” and side-splitting humor in an evening fit for all ages.

Flip FabriQue was created in 2011 by alumni of l’École de Cirque de Québec (Quebec City Circus School) and is comprised of Jeremie Arsenault, Hugo Ouellet Coté, Bruno Gagnon, Francis Julien, and Jade Dussault. They have performed extensively with esteemed companies around the world such as Cirque du Soleil and Cirque Éloize. “Catch Me!” was nominated for a Drama Desk Award for Unique Theatrical Experience, and was awarded three prizes in the 2013 International Circus Festival. The company adopts a creative and collaborative approach developed entirely by its artists and director.
