Singer/Songwriter Martin Sexton Celebrates New Release at Weinberg

FREDERICK, Md., Thursday, October 5, 2017 — Hailed as “a star with the potential to permanently affect the musical landscape” by Billboard, Martin Sexton will bring his trio to the Weinberg Center for the Arts stage on Saturday, October 21 at 8:00pm. The singer/songwriter, who is best known for incendiary albums like “Black Sheep” and “Seeds,” is touring in support of his latest release, “Mixtape of the Open Road.”

A native of Syracuse, NY, Martin Sexton migrated to Boston in the early 1990s, where he began to build a following singing on the streets of Harvard Square. His albums include “In the Journey,” “Black Sheep,” “The American,” “Wonder Bar,” “Live Wide Open,” “Seeds,” “Solo,” and “Sugarcoating.” He can also be heard singing “Working Class Hero” as part of “The 30th Annual John Lennon Tribute” album. Sexton regularly sells out venues from New York’s Nokia Theatre to L.A.’s House of Blues, and tours regularly across Canada and Europe. He has collaborated with the likes of John Mayer and Peter Frampton, and has performed at venues including the Newport Folk Fest, Bonnaroo, the New Orleans Jazz Fest, and Carnegie Hall. In 2002, he launched his own label, KTR. His songs can be heard in many feature films and television including “Scrubs,” “Parenthood,” and the Showtime hit series “Brotherhood.” Sexton has also performed at benefits for a variety of causes, including Paul Newman’s Hole in the Wall Gang camp, the Children’s Tumor Foundation, Japan earthquake/tsunami relief efforts (The John Lennon Tribute), and Hurricane Irene relief efforts in Vermont.
