Sawyer Brown and Clint Black Join Weinberg Center Lineup

FREDERICK, Md., Tuesday, December 19, 2017 — 99.9 WFRE Free Country Rewind will present Clint Black and Sawyer Brown at the Weinberg Center for the Arts on March 22, 2018 and April 22, 2018, respectively. Both performances will begin at 7pm.

Tickets for both performances are now on sale to Weinberg Center members, and will become available to the general public on Friday, December 22 at 10am. Tickets and memberships may be purchased online at WeinbergCenter.org, by calling the Box Office at 301.600.2828, or in person at 20 West Patrick St.

Clint Black surged to superstardom as part of the fabled Class of '89, reaching #1 with five consecutive singles from his triple-platinum debut, "Killin' Time." Best known for more than three dozen chart hits including "A Better Man," "When My Ship Comes In," "A Good Run of Bad Luck," and "Like the Rain," Black has multiple GRAMMY® nominations, over 20 million records sold, and a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame. Tickets for this performance begin at \$40.

Sawyer Brown's energetic shows have earned them the nickname "the Rolling Stones of country music." The travelin' band has played over 4,500 shows, with 23 albums, more than 50 chart singles, and multiple CMA, ACM, and CMT awards to their name. Tickets for this performance begin at \$35.
