Classic Album "Led Zeppelin II" to be Performed Live at Weinberg

FREDERICK, Md., Wednesday, December 27, 2017 — Classic Albums Live will return to the Weinberg Center for the Arts on Friday, January 19 with a concert presentation of “Led Zeppelin II.” The group’s groundbreaking second album will be performed note for note, cut for cut, followed by a selection of Led Zeppelin’s greatest hits. The event will begin at 8:00pm.

Classic Albums Live takes classic albums from the 60s and 70s and recreates them live on stage - note for note, cut for cut. Using the world's best musicians, fans are treated to an exact replication of the album followed by a second set of the featured artist's greatest hits. Musicians are chosen according to their sound and their fit into a particular niche, be it David Bowie, Pink Floyd, The Beatles, or The Stones. The album might require a sitar player, a children's choir, a string quartet or someone to ring the alarm clock. Whatever it takes, the musicians treat these revered albums like a score... the way a symphony orchestra treats Mozart.
